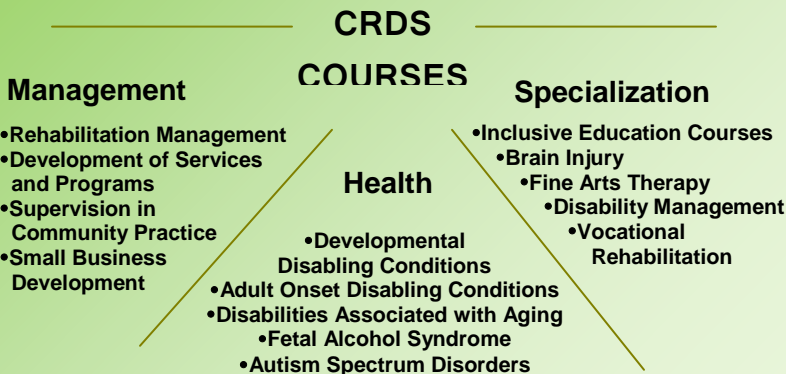
There is a 4-yr. interdisciplinary program offered on-campus only.
