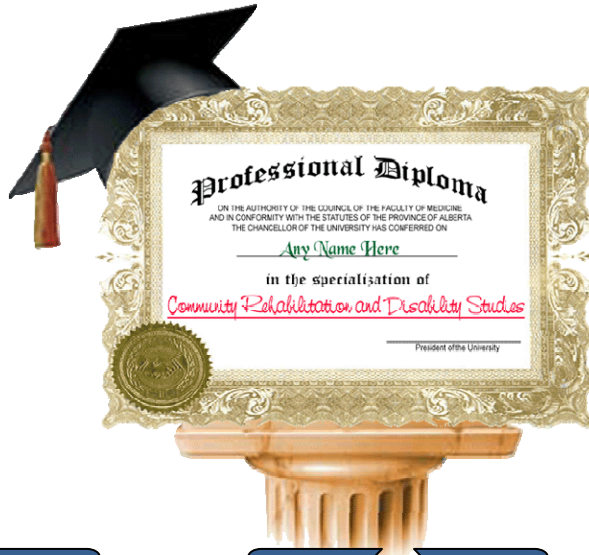

How to Apply

First steps:

1. Set up an interview with the program director (403) 220-2985
2. Provide a copy of your unofficial transcripts
3. Your proposal will go to the Faculty of Education Student Program Office

What you will need:

1. Completed U of C "Application for Admission" form
2. \$100 application fee
3. "Change of Program" form if you are currently completing a University of Calgary degree

Applications: April 1
Transcripts: June 30

- ✓ Maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.0
